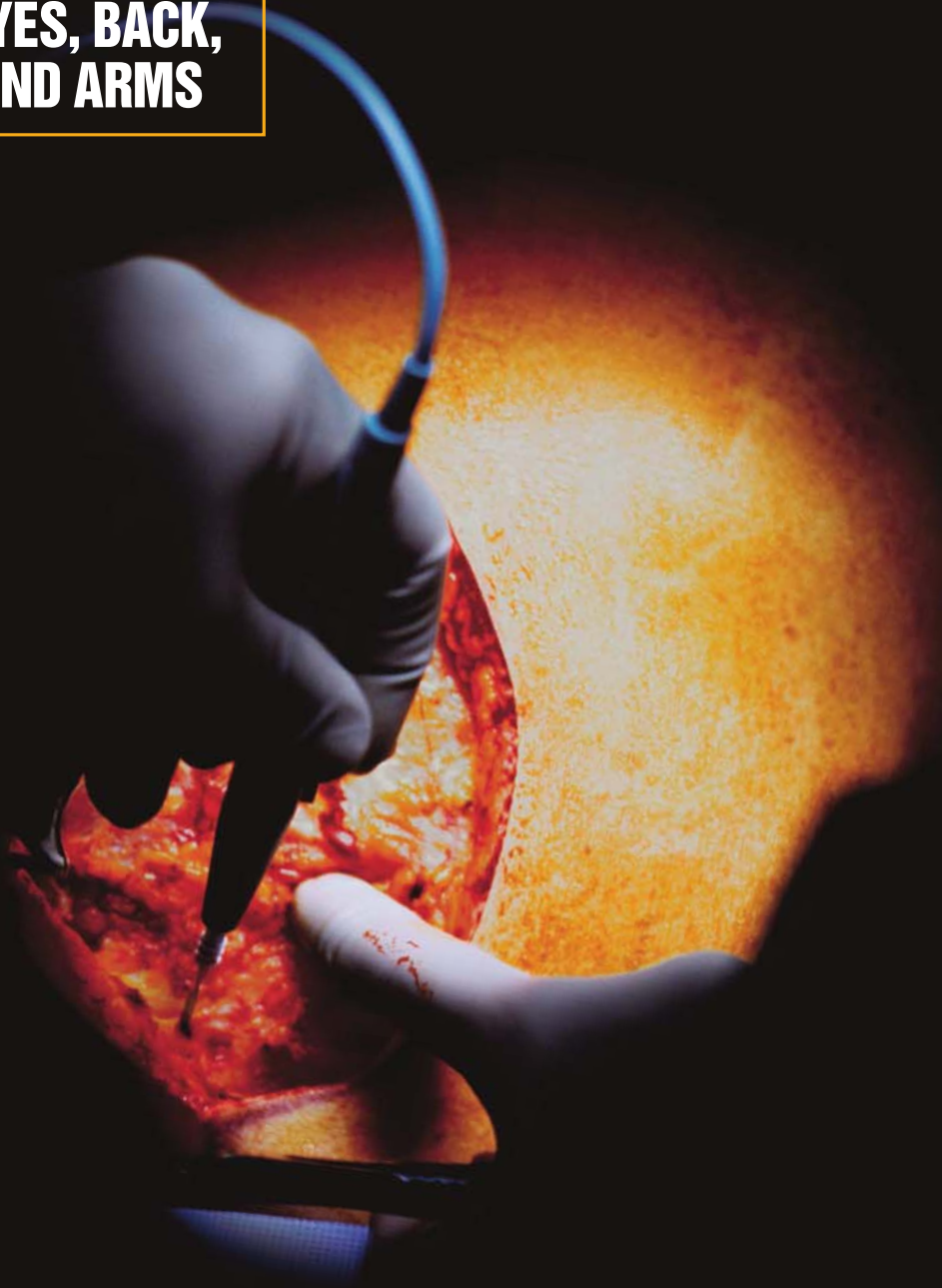


**IF THIS OFFENDS YOU,
